DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Because I want our production to be a brief guide to all Aristophanes' works I will not use up precious time and space on theories and analyses.

I will say only that I had two main reasons for wanting to direct here for the first time. The first was my love (with all its ups and downs) for ancient drama, both tragedy and comedy. It is a love that I was lucky enough to be initiated into in various stages from an early age: as a young and fervent theatre goer, at school and university, acting alongside the best in the business, later as a teacher at the same schools and universities and, finally, as a director. The second reason was the difficulties that exist regarding the place of Aristophanean comedy in the modern age and how it should be performed.

I have therefore tried to use whatever skills I have developed during my career to penetrate the secret world of The Frogs, hoping to find a way - though not of course the only way - to bring Aristophanes' ancient drama into the present day.
